Dear parents,

We are pleased to inform about the national-level science talent search examination Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM) for students of classes VI to XI, organized by Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA) in collaboration with the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) and National Council of Science Museums (NCSM). Examination will be based on Science, Mathematics, Indian Contribution to Science and Life of Dr. S.N. Bose.

Why register for VVM?

- Expands knowledge in science-based subjects and India's scientific contributions.
 - Develops critical thinking, problem-solving, and analytical skills.
 - Provides exposure to leading R&D institutions and renowned scientists.
 - Includes opportunities for extensive internships at national research labs.
 - Enhances communication and presentation abilities through various activities.
 - Familiarizes students with modern, app-based examination platforms.
 - Recognizes achievements with participation, merit, and winner certificates
- **Participation Certificate:** All students who appear for the VVM Level-I examination.
 - **Merit Certificate:** Top 3 rankers per class at the **School Level** and at the **District Level**.
 - **State Camp Participation Certificate:** Students who qualify for and attend the **State Level Camp (SLC)**.
 - **State Camp Winner Certificate:** Top 3 rankers per class at the **State Level Camp**.
 - **National Camp Participation Certificate:** Students who qualify for and attend the **National Camp**.
 - **National Camp Winner Certificate (Himalayans) & Zonal Winner Certificate:** Top 3 rankers per class at the **National Level** and **Zonal Level**.

Registration of Students from School/Institute

School Coordinator will register each student by filling up their details in the VVM Portal. **Students are requested to bring a registration fee of ₹200 per student in an envelope with the following details mentioned on top of it.**

Necessary Details for Student Registration:

- Student's Full Name
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Class
- Language of Exam
- Parent/Guardian Name
- Parent/Guardian Mobile Number and Email ID
- Student's Mobile Number and Email ID (if student's mobile is to be used to appear for the exam)
- Device Information: Students should specify the device (smartphone/mobile, laptop, or desktop) they intend to use for the exam to ensure compatibility with the VVM Exam App.

Post-Registration and Examination Details

- **Exam App:** Students will receive an SMS and Email notification to download the latest VVM Exam App three days before their chosen exam date. This download must be done at least two days before the exam. Students will not be able to appear for the exam without the latest updated App.
- **Exam Login:** Students can log in to the Exam App anytime from 10:00 AM to 06:00 PM on their selected exam date to write the exam. They can login only once.

NB: Last date of submitting the registration fee is 18th August, 2025 to avail Mock Test facility.
